

وفي المجال الريّاضي فاز فريقُ المدرسة الدّولية للفنون والعلوم ISAS في كرّة السّلة بكأسِ مسابقة الجامعة الأميريكية في الشارقة 'شراكة'.

أمًا في المجالِ الفنّي فقد شارك طلاب مدارس AMSI بالعديد من المعارض تحت رعاية هيئة المعرفة والتنمية البشرية والعديد من المساباقات على مستوى الدولة، منها جائزة الشيخ ماجد الإعلامية للشباب ومهرجان دبي الدولي للفنون...


