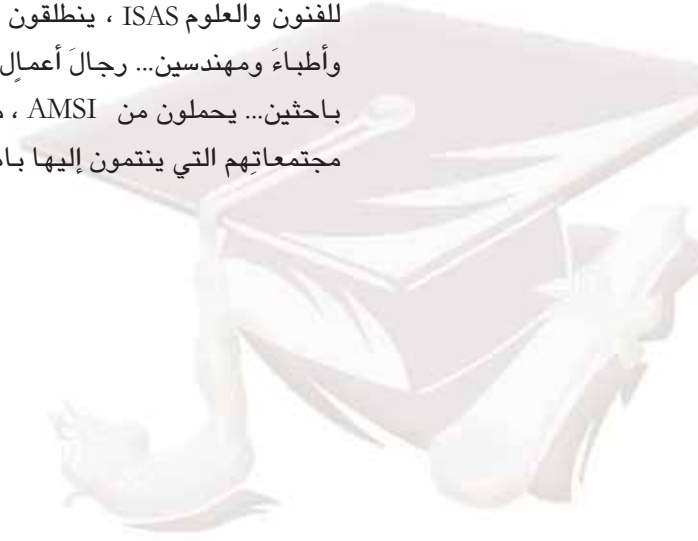
'فعلّم ما استطعت لعلّ جيلاً يثور فيُحدّث العَجَبَ العُجَاباً'

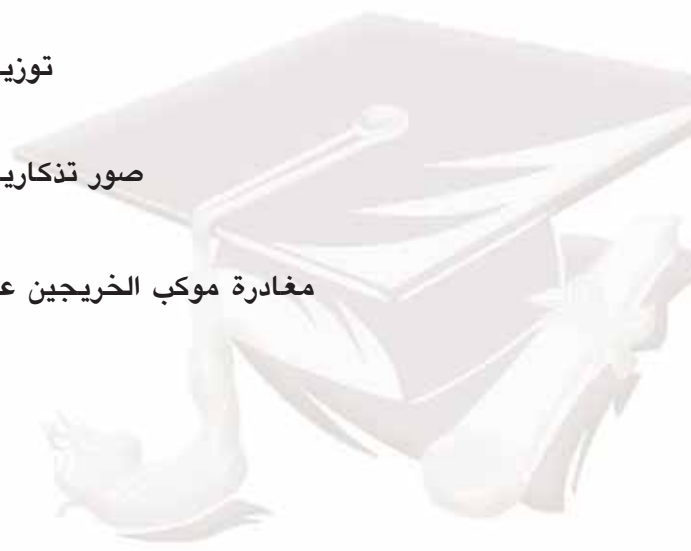

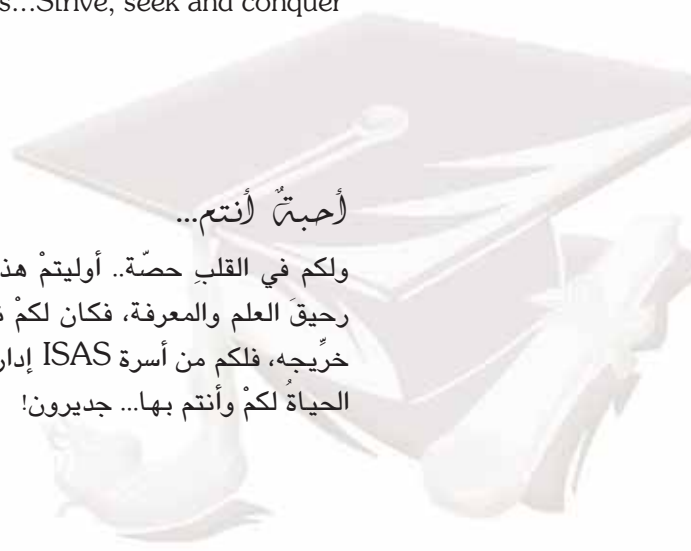
