Although our medium of instruction is English, we follow a unique trilingual education program in English, French, and Arabic which enables our graduates to pursue higher education worldwide. The students begin studying the English, French, and Arabic languages as of Kindergarten.

Students of Grade 10, 11, 12 follow an academic US-style curriculum (equivalent to a US Grade 12 Diploma). There is one common curriculum without streams. Subjects are compulsory. Non Muslim students are exempted from Islamic Education.

N4B initiative

In Gr.11 – 12, where the Notebooks 4 Books (N4B) environment is deployed, the technology is advanced. All high school classrooms are N4B equipped, which are structured to allow the use of notebook computers in the place of traditional books in the high school. This gives students immense access to resources with the teachers' supervision.

Al Mawakeb Schools had also launched AMS-online on Sept23rd, 2000 which provides a link with our parents. This service also continues to enhance our admin-parents communication efficiency.
